

Medical Supply Donation Policy

Thank you for offering a donation to Humane Animal Rescue of Pittsburgh of any extra medications, syringes, flea treatments, and medical supplies you may have on hand. Under Federal regulations, we are no longer permitted to accept any prescription medications from the public. All medication used on our animals must be supplied by our facility and dispensed only to the pets that our Veterinarians have a Client/Vet/Pet relationship. This means that our Doctors can only use medications that we purchased and prescribed for pets they have seen in our clinic and the shelter pets in our care. All medications donated by the public are now considered “adulterated drugs” and cannot be used on the animals in our care because our Vet did not purchase the medication. Your generosity in donating to our ARL is greatly appreciated. May we suggest that you check our Wish List items to see if you may have anything that we can accept like blankets, towels, office supplies, etc.
